

Pupil Premium Funding 2015 – 2016

Impact Statement

The Pupil Premium allocation of funds for the financial year was a total of £117,820.00.

The Pupil Premium money was used last academic year to employ additional staff to work with children who were entitled to the funding, in order to accelerate their learning in reading, writing and mathematics.

The money was also used to employ the Inclusion Manager and Education Welfare Officer who support children and families throughout school.

The impact of the funding has been that the attainment gap between disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged children has narrowed:

- Disadvantaged KS2 pupils had an average scaled score equal to or above the national score for other pupils in reading.
