Romans for an Afternoon!

Following this we were told that we were going to be Roman slaves working for the cloth merchant. We needed to make the dye to colour the cloth for the rich and important Romans.



We collected natural seeds, coloured stems and yellow dandelions. We also used onion skins.

We had to cut and crush them to break them down and release the colour.

Finally we added hot water and vinegar as a fixing agent (to hold the colour in the cloth).
